**General Information**

Students will not be allowed to take courses out of sequence. Students starting the program late may experience some delay in graduation because of sequencing. Credit will not be granted for courses taken out of sequence. It is your responsibility to drop any courses for which you have registered and for which you have not met the prerequisites. You may be dropped at any time from courses when prerequisites have not been met.

**Credits and University Requirements**

In order to graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration you must complete: 128 credits, all major requirements, all Discovery Program requirements, all University Writing Intensive requirements, and have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0.
