<https://www.jobscan.com/>: New website that allows you to compare the actual resume you created for the posting with the posting itself. Matches key words to let you know how well your resume will do in an ATS system and shows what skills (soft & hard) are missing. The free service lets you use it five times per month. Yearly subscription give unlimited use.
